

ELECTIONS TO THE BOARD AND GENERAL COUNCIL

Article 6 of the Society's constitution lays out the mechanisms for running the General Council. As a result of these terms, there will be a number of vacancies to be filled with effect from 1 January 2027, as set out below.

Nominations are invited from fully paid-up members of the Society for the following vacancies, which would require the following number of sponsors to support the nomination:

Regional member, North East*	Six sponsors
Regional member, London & South East*	Six sponsors

Regional member, Scotland*	Six sponsors
Regional member, Southern*	Six sponsors
Regional member, Western*	Six sponsors
Regional member, Yorkshire & Humberside*	Six sponsors
Student representative	Six sponsors

[†] Some incumbent members are eligible to stand for a second term.

* Regional members must be nominated from among their own number by members within the region. If no nominations are received, these vacancies will be made available to National candidates.

A copy of the nomination form appears overleaf. The member nominated must countersign a nomination form, but the nominating members may use different forms. Nominations may also be made online at www.theorsociety.com/GCelections.

Completed nomination forms must be received by the Executive Director on or before 30 September 2026. LATE NOMINATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Nominating Someone?

Nominating a fellow member to one of these positions is not something to be taken lightly. By doing so you are vouching for his / her character and his / her desire and ability to carry out the role on behalf of you and your fellow members. You are essentially agreeing that your nominee is a fit and proper person to undertake the specific role.

You are at liberty to nominate more than one person, even for the same role.
