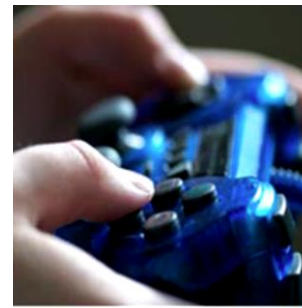
Praise / Issue / Problem:

Praise / Issue / Problem:

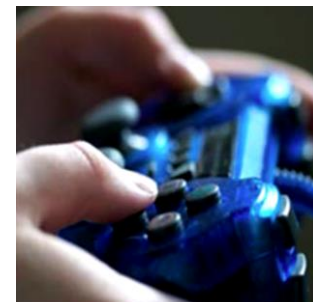
You are currently creating an online booking system. Unfortunately, there is a fault in the system...two families have booked the last available room for the same time period! You must, therefore, make a decision. You can either:
