## Measuring inventiveness and choice in GP prescribing practice

- Measuring surgery culture (inventiveness vs caution)
- If we plot the range of medications prescribed by a GP surgery against the prescription rate (the number of prescriptions per month), we find that
- the range of medication increases as the rate increases, but
- this tails off for busier surgeries (prescription fatigue)
- We can characterise each surgery as inventive or cautious

- Measuring medication choice
- If we now plot the **range** of medications **for a given medication class** against the prescription **rate** (the number of prescriptions per month), we find again that
- the **range** of medication increases as the **rate** increases
- Some medication classes provide good choice
- Other medication classes need more options
